## 2009 Conference Speakers

**Scott Morton** serves with The Navigators as Vice President of Development for U.S. ministries and is a member of the National Leadership Team. He graduated from Iowa State University in technical journalism and worked in newspaper advertising before joining the Navigator staff in 1970. Previous assignments include Columbia, Missouri; Iowa City, Iowa; Madison, Wisconsin; Minneapolis, Minnesota; and short-term ministries in Asia and Europe. He has served in Development since 1985 and has been on the National Leadership Team since 2004.

The Mortons enjoy baseball (Scott was drafted by the Baltimore Orioles and Minnesota Twins), bird-watching, antiques and helping people grow in their spiritual journeys through small group Bible studies and one-on-one mentoring. Scott also enjoys writing, having published *Funding Your Ministry (Whether You're Gifted or Not)*, a book to help missionaries raise financial support, *Down to Earth Discipling*, a realistic approach to sharing one's faith with others and *Tired of Do-List Christianity?* which helps debunk the misconceptions that hold back spiritual growth and steal our joy.

**Dean Coddington** is a Senior Consultant with McManis Consulting in Greenwood Village, Colorado. Dean is an economist, who now emphasizes the economics of the Health Care Industry. He has authored several strategic books dealing with this important subject.

Formerly, he was with Denver Research Institute at DU before entering private practice. He and his wife are long-time members of Mission Hills Church in Greenwood Village. He also has co-authored a book on early American history, "God Bless America."

**Janice Reed Liebler, RDH** graduated from University of Minnesota Dental Hygiene School. Over the years, Jan has accompanied her husband on 14 mission trips to Russia, Ukraine and Israel. At home, she has been a counselor for seven years at the Women's Pregnancy Center in Miami, Florida and later a member of Leaders Group in Women's Bible Study Fellowship for eight years. She attends Granada Presbyterian Church in Coral Gables where she teaches a women's Sunday School and is past president of Women of the Church. She currently is enrolled in "Precepts" and hosts Focus on the Family's "Truth Project".

**Robert Kinsaul, DMD** of Phoenix City, the ADA's 2008 Humanitarian Award recipient, has provided volunteer dental care on every continent except Antarctica and Australia. "I haven't been to Antarctica yet, but I'm going one of these days," said Dr. Kinsaul, who has since 1976 logged 59 international mission trips-from Siberia to South America-to help those in desperate need. "It's been 32 years worth of excitement to me."

The ADA Humanitarian Award recognizes dentist members who have distinguished themselves by outstanding, unselfish leadership and contributions to their fellow human beings in the field of dentistry through the dedication of extraordinary time and professional skills to improve the oral health of underserved populations within the United States and abroad.

He will soon be returning to Rameswaram, India, where he is helping to establish a 2,400-square-foot dental clinic. He was also instrumental in setting up dental clinics in El Salvador, Afghanistan and Russia. Dr. Kinsaul even flew a Russian dentist and his bilingual office manager from the Moscow clinic to the U.S. at his own expense. They received a week of training in his 14-chair dental office to learn how to treat multiple patients more effectively in their clinic and an additional week to see some of the sights.

**Billy Graham Paulose** has been serving the people in India since 1979. He and his family live on Rameswaram Island. This small island at the Southern tip of India is the location that one million Indians make their pilgrimage to each year to try to wash away their sins in the river and to perform brutal rituals.

Billy Graham Paulose has trained and sent out over 5,000 evangelists to share the free gift of salvation that Jesus offers. Billy has been beaten and some men were paid to cut off his wife's head and his head - the Lord spared them. Their training center has been burned down twice and they are in the process of building another one. Billy and his family also have an orphanage in which a little girl named "Grace" was rescued from being boiled alive.
