The CDS held exhibit booths at the Rocky Mountain Convention in Denver on Jan. 23-25, the Yankee meeting in Boston on Jan. 30-Feb. 1, and at the Chicago Midwinter meeting on Feb. 20-22. These were great opportunities to connect,

teach, inform, and help other people with dental missions. The CDS will be at the Hinman meeting in Atlanta on March 19-21 and at the Anaheim meeting on May 14-16. It is not too early to plan for the ADA meeting in Orlando, Florida on Oct. 15-17. Note that the convention center in Orlando has three, large buildings and they are spread out. The ADA will be in the West building and not the North or South buildings. The CDS will not have a designated hotel as so many like to choose and have points or rewards to use. There are lots of hotels available, but few within walking distance of the West building. To give you an idea, Dr. Bob and Diane Meyer booked one of the closest hotels, within easy walking distance to the convention, called the Midpointe Hotel by Rosen Hotels and Resorts through Hotels.com for \$85 a night, which includes all taxes and fees.

A special thanks to those who filled out an e-mail survey and gave an interview on “Recruitment Considerations for Christian, Dental, Short-Term Missions Relating to the Holistic Development of Dentists.” Diane Meyer received over 400 responses back and interviewed 60 experts in the field of dental missions who had done an average of 55 mission trips. This valuable input has been documented and tabulated in a 300-page, doctoral dissertation looking at the benefits and the detractors of doing dental missions. There was encouraging data and stories strongly reinforcing dental mission, holistic benefits and how detractors have been overcome. Diane will present this dissertation at the Christian distance learning conference at Abilene Christian University in Dallas in March, and defend the dissertation at Liberty University in Virginia in April as the CDS looks forward to using this study for dental mission recruitment.
