**Dr. T. Bob Davis** has taken more than 1,500 dental students and about 500 dentists to Latin America over the past 36 years on dental missions. Dr. T. Bob, who is currently the President of Academy of Dentistry International, says, “Do what you can while you still can!” He was featured in the April 17<sup>th</sup> edition of the ADA News. Dr. T. Bob and Janis have a private dental practice in Dallas, Texas. Dr. T. Bob has over a dozen CD’s published as a professional concert pianist and will also be playing music at the banquet, so we are in for a real treat.

**Dr. Andrew Walls** is a young, energetic, and up and coming CDS member (he will join the CDS Advisory Council this year). He and his wife, Rebecca, attended the first formal CDS dental mission training trip in Mexicali, Mexico in December 2015, which was directed by **Dr. Gayle and Nita Cheatwood**. Dr. Andrew’s in-laws are missionaries in Thailand and he wanted to take his young family there to not only visit, but to provide much needed dental care. Dr. Andrew, and his wife Rebecca, had little knowledge about how to do a portable dental mission. After the CDS training, they felt confident doing portable dentistry and took their children to Thailand. 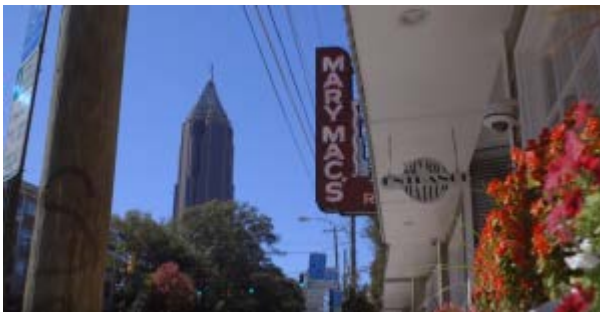

### **Dental Conferences in 2017:**

**Dr. Kathy Barlow and Dr. Bob Liebler**, CDS Board Members, will hold a CDS booth at the Florida meeting on June 22-24.

The Academy of General Dentistry invoked a new ruling this year eliminating complimentary exhibit booths at their yearly convention. It would have cost the CDS over \$2,000 to register for a booth at the upcoming Las Vegas AGD convention in July. **Dr. Denny Scharine, CDS President, and Dr. Bob Meyer, CDS Executive Director**, wrote letters and talked to the AGD, trying to convince them that it was important to have volunteer organizations at the local conventions who advocated humanitarian work as a worthy endeavor for dental personnel. The CDS just received news that we will be granted a complimentary booth space at the **July 13-15 AGD dental conference in Las Vegas and Dr. Bob and Diane Meyer** will run the CDS booth. Praise the Lord! Kudo's to the AGD for changing their decision.

The CDS will also hold exhibit booths at the California Dental Meeting in **San Francisco, August 24-26**, at the Ohio Dental Meeting in **Columbus, September 14-16**, at the Greater New York Dental Meeting in **New York City (over 50,000 dental participants) on November 26-29**, and at the Rocky Mountain Dental Convention in **Denver on January 18-20, 2018**. The CDS is connecting with hundreds of dental, mission-minded individuals in the exhibit halls, and the booths have been a significant way to impact others in our profession.
