We still have challenges ahead in this revival process, and we have lots of work to do. I count on your prayers and helping hands for our CDS that is growing and renewing with young dentists and energizing ideas.

I would like to introduce myself for those who don't know me. I was a full-time dentist missionary and church planter, with a family of three young children.

For the past five years, I have been married to a gift of God in my life, Dr. Scott Hewitt. He is a mission-oriented man of God with whom I share my call in my later years, and he is also part of our CDS Advisory Council. His experience in dental missions is different from mine because he is a short-term mission dentist—as are most CDS members.

I began my mission career as the first female, Brazilian missionary dentist in South America. I had a call and an insatiable desire to serve, but had no role model or advanced technology to help or advise me. (It was before the existence of the Internet or computers.) It was not easy, but God was always in control. During the first week in the mission field, I became gravely ill, my oldest son was kidnapped, and my family experienced life-threatening political situations. We all survived for 25 years, and I am here to tell it to you that I am full of joy and without regrets in my heart. My three children are successful, Christian adults, and we have six grandchildren.

I started with only a self-designed, dental trailer, limited equipment, few supplies (no masks or gloves), and I did not speak the language of my first assigned country when I became a career missionary. I had to figure out on my own how to engineer the optimum setup of not only the dental/medical portion of the mission, but also all that was involved for our outreach programs. Ultimately, with God's infinite grace, I was privileged to be used to plant eight churches in four countries, and I've shared the Gospel in 37 countries around the world. We saw hundreds of people give their lives to Christ (and I am still counting). That was 37 years ago. With today's technologies and ease of travel, think how much you can accomplish to advance God's kingdom.

If a young, female, Brazilian, missionary dentist could do it, so can you! CDS can offer you all the advice and support you need to fully utilize your talents and desire to serve HIS people, ANYPLACE, ANYWHERE, ANYTIME.

The Board Meeting of the CDS



CDS Board and Advisory Council at ADA meeting

The Board Meeting of the CDS discussed many items related to CDS business, development, and growth. Important agenda items are summarized below:

- During the past year, the CDS has enjoyed God's blessings with a 100% increase in membership, has published a Dental Mission Manual for Portable Short-term Dental Trips, and has exhibited at eight major dental conferences. The CDS is setting up teaching programs in Mexicali, Mexico with Dr. Gayle Cheatwood and in Cozumel, Mexico with Dr. Monica Oliveria-Hewitt. We are developing new portable dental units, and our members are supporting more dental trips as we encourage, assist, and equip missions worldwide.
- Dr. Monica Oliveira-Hewitt assumed the reigns of President and Dr. Robert Meyer became the CDS Executive Director. Dr. Jody Yarbro replaced Dr. Robert Liebler as Treasurer, and Dr. Kathleen Barlow was elected as our Board Secretary. Mrs. Tina Wendel remains as the CDS Executive Secretary and continues as our only paid employee. New Board Members this year include Dr. Randy Sanders and Dr. David Moretz. New Advisory Council members include: Dr. Dan Hudson, Ms. Lynelle DeRoo, BSDH, and Mrs. Diane Meyer, BSN, MST.
- Dr. Randy Sanders reported on the CDS rental of kits and sterilizers: 38 trips and 890 "kit use days" were accomplished so far this year. He will replenish instruments with CDS resources. Hygienist kits will soon be available.
- Dr. David Moretz supplied CDS large equipment items for 26 trips this year to date. The Board discussed options for buying new portable equipment.
- Dr. James Wolf is adding a spot on the CDS website whereby dental personnel can inform others of their mission trip locations and their needs for other participants.
- All CDS members are encouraged to improve the CDS Facebook site.
