We are currently **working on revising and updating our website member lists** to make them even better. We are finding that many of our members have not updated their biographical data—such as their private and public address, phone numbers, e-mails, and website. To easily do this, please go to our website: www.christiandental.org and go to the “Members’ Area” or the “Directory” and select the section that says: “Members. . . update your information today! Click Here.” If you do not remember our password, it is “Jesus.”

The CDS maintains two separate member data lists to maintain confidentiality. The “*Members’ Directory*” under the “Members’ Area” can only be accessed with the password “Jesus,” and the data is designated (private). The “*Directory*” is for public access and the data is designated (public). Generally, your office information goes in the “Directory” and your home information goes on the “Members’ Directory.” If you do not have office information, you can leave the public data blank or put whatever information you feel comfortable sharing with others. Listing office information, to include your website, often generates new patients looking on the Internet for Christian Dentists.

Trip opportunities: If you have a trip planned and want to get the word out to others, go to the CDS website www.christiandental.org under “Members,” click on the “Mission Trip Opportunity,” fill out the simple trip information data, and submit so that your trip can be advertised. This is facilitated by **Dr. Jim Wolf**.

It weighs in at 37 pounds with room for additional items and is small enough to be carried onto the plane. As you probably know, the

Aseptico Task Force unit, which we have been renting out works well, but the case often does not hold up. The first prototype Aseptico Task Force reconfigured unit functioned well on a trip to Guatemala and is now in Uganda. If you have a Task Force unit with a broken case, consider sending it to Paul at Bell Dental and he can place it in a hard case to protect it.

Dr. Gayle Cheatwood is designing a 12-volt dental operating unit system which is almost ready and was recently tested on mission trips to Mexico and Romania.

We are **testing out a portable field ultrasonic unit** to go with our hygiene kits that will soon be available for rental. The portable unit functioned well in Guatemala and is now being tested by **Dr. Denis Scharine** on a mission trip. The CDS desires to rent out only field-tested, dependable, portable equipment for dental mission trips.

Our members continue to be heavily involved with dental missions here and overseas. Thank you and blessings to all CDS members who continue to support our unique mission of encouraging, assisting, training, and equipping dental personnel to provide dental care to the underserved and to open doors in support of God's kingdom.
